**REMINDERS**

- All contestant assistants must be in full attire: long sleeve shirt, hat, and boots – see Rule Contestant Disqualifications in your rulebook.
- All contestants must have their number on and visible at all times while on the rodeo grounds – see Rule Contestant Disqualifications in your rulebook. This includes the contestants dance.

**POINT SYSTEM**

The rodeo will consist of 3 separate rodeos. Each day will be utilizing the NHSRA point system of 10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1. Total points for the weekend will be 30. The top four contestants in each event after the weekend will qualify for the Wrangler Division Junior High Finals Rodeo in Gallup, New Mexico.

**2009/2010 ELECTIONS:**

We will be electing the 2009 Board of Directors, Executive Board (one representative from each district within the state of Idaho) and Student Officers at the State meeting Saturday evening.

**STALL SHAVINGS:** Shavings are available for purchase at the fairgrounds for \$7.00 per bag through Kelli Taylor in the camping area.

**NATIONAL QUALIFIERS:** The top four contestants in each event will qualify for the National Finals in – Gallup, New Mexico June 28<sup>th</sup>-July 4<sup>th</sup>.. Contestants that qualify must be prepared to make that commitment on Sunday. 5<sup>th</sup> place contestants need to be available in case a position comes open for a National spot.

- **ALL ENTRY INFORMATION AND PAYMENT MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF RIGHT AFTER THE AWARDS CEREMONY ON SUNDAY. IF YOU DO NOT PLAN TO CONTINUE ON TO NATIONALS, AND ARE IN THE TOP FOUR PLACINGS, PLEASE LET US KNOW SO THE NEXT PERSON HAS THE OPTION TO GO.**
- **Both natural parents and/or legal guardians (full custody parent if divorced) MUST be available to sign all the National forms on Sunday.**
- **All Idaho participants must wear their team shirt for the team picture at nationals. This is not an option. You will not be involved in any Idaho State Team Activities at Nationals (volleyball, NRA shooting, etc.) You will be expected to purchase this shirt on Sunday. The cost is \$25.00.**
- **Although the directors try to get the correct sizes, that is not always possible. These shirts are sold on a first-come, first-serve basis. Shirts can be tailored for a minimal price in your home town.**
- **Camping sites at nationals are limited; therefore, we will have a computer generated draw for these spots at the awards ceremony.**
- **One performance at nationals will be Tough Enough to Wear Pink. Be prepared for this and pack appropriately.**
