

# N.H.S.R.A. Idaho Wrangler Division Expectations

1. Follow rules in and out of the arena. Do not let a personal decision affect your jr. high rodeo career. Remember your decisions can affect the whole state, not just you.
2. Do not be late for your event or rodeo!!! It is important you are on time.
3. Represent the State of Idaho in the most sportsmanlike manner possible. You are expected to be competitive and proud but not in a taunting manner. This includes all activities you are involved with.
4. Be responsible by being in rodeo attire. Make sure your shirts are tucked in and sleeves down. Show pride in representing the 'western' heritage and the sport of rodeo.
5. Be respectful to ALL participants of the Wrangler Division Junior Rodeo Association. This includes participants, competitors, judges, parents and adults.
6. Remember: You earn a spot on any team. Being involved in the sport of RODEO is a privilege, not a RIGHT. You are expected to follow the rules and not one individual is more important than another is.
7. Support each other. You all are part of a team, be there for each other. Any conflicts out of the arena need to STAY OUT of the arena. When you are in the arena, you need to focus on RODEO and be responsible for YOURSELF.
8. Remember YOU ARE PROUD to be FROM the State of Idaho and your actions need to follow your words.
9. Be responsible in school. Do not miss class unless necessary. You are expected to be a "Student Athlete".
10. I understand that anything that I put on the World Wide Web (for example: Myspace.com) should represent myself, my family, fellow contestants and Junior High School Rodeo in a positive manner.
