#### **2010 RODEO SCHEDULE:**

##### **June 3<sup>rd</sup> Thur-Contestant Check In, Pick Up Packets**

**Contestant Shoot** Starts @ 10:00 a.m. (Contestants check-in at rodeo office prior to reporting to Shoot). Paige Ireland will be sending out the Shooting Contestant Rules and additional information concerning this event. Shooting will take place throughout the entire day.

Goat's will be tied at 6:00 p.m. Contestants can meet behind the roping chutes.

8:00 a.m. Mandatory Contestant Meeting, Main Grand Stands  
Full Contestant Picture in Main Arena following Contestant Meeting

State Meeting will start ½ hour following Saturday's rodeo.

National Qualifiers Meeting Registration following Awards Ceremony.  
National fees will be expected to be paid at this time. It is also important that both parents are available for signatures on all paperwork.

#### **REMINDERS**

- All contestant assistants must be in full attire: long sleeve shirt, hat, boots – see Rule Contestant Disqualifications in your rulebook.
- All contestants must have their number on and visible at all times while on the rodeo grounds – see Rule Contestant Disqualifications in your rulebook.
- Please read enclosed specific information concerning the dress code and the contestant dance.

#### **POINT SYSTEM**

The rodeo will consist of 3 separate rodeos each day. The rodeo point system will be utilizing the NHSRA point system of 10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1. Total points for the weekend will be 30 in each event. The top four contestants in each event after the weekend will qualify for the Wrangler Division Junior High Finals Rodeo in Gallup, New Mexico to be held June 27-July 3, 2010.

**2010-2011 ELECTIONS:**

Student Officers will be elected at the State meeting Saturday evening. Please get to know your nominees and vote for the best person to represent your state.

**NATIONAL QUALIFIERS:** The top four contestants in each event will qualify for the National Finals on June 27 - July 3 in Gallup, New Mexico. **Contestants that qualify must be prepared to make that commitment on Sunday. 5<sup>th</sup> place contestants need to be available in case a position comes open for a National spot. ALL ENTRY INFORMATION AND PAYMENT MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF RIGHT AFTER THE AWARDS CEREMONY ON SUNDAY. IF YOU DO NOT PLAN TO CONTINUE ON TO NATIONALS, AND ARE IN THE TOP FOUR PLACINGS, PLEASE LET US KNOW SO THE NEXT PERSON HAS THE OPTION TO GO. Both natural parents and/or legal guardians (full custody parent if divorced) MUST be available to sign all the National forms on Sunday.**

**TEAM SHIRTS:** The contestants will be expected to purchase one team shirt for nationals. The price for the shirt is \$35.00 each.

**FLAG CARRIERS:** Report to the grand entry gate 15 minutes before the performance begins. Please check in with Kelli Taylor.

**STALL SHAVINGS:** Shavings are available for purchase at the fairgrounds for \$7.00 per bag through Kelli Taylor in the camping area.
